HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To receive a Secondary School Diploma (DES) a student must:

- 1. Accumulate a minimum of 54 credits in Secondary 4 and 5.
- 2. Twenty (20) of these credits must be at the Secondary 5 level.

Course codes identify the grade level (first digit) as well as the number of credits earned for the course (last digit). For example: Math 414 – Sec IV level course worth 4 credits.
